The total expense ratio is 1.34% (as of most recent prospectus). First Pacific Adviser, LP (the "Adviser" or "FPA"), the Fund's investment adviser, has contractually agreed to reimburse the Fund for Total Annual Fund Operating Expenses in excess of 1.29% of the average net assets of the Fund (excluding brokerage fees and commissions, interest, taxes, fees and expenses of other funds in which the Fund invests, and extraordinary expenses, including litigation expenses not incurred in the Fund's ordinary course of business) through April 30, 2021. This agreement may only be terminated earlier by the Fund's Board of Directors or upon termination of the Advisory Agreement.

Average Weighting is calculated by taking the sum of each quarter-end asset category weight and dividing it by the number of months for the time period.
